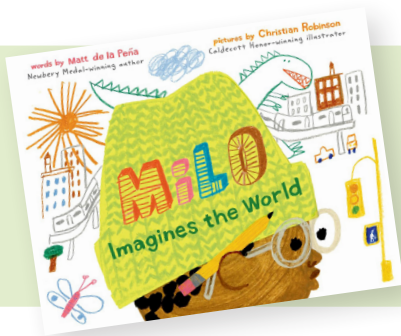


Pre/Post Activities

Milo Imagines the World

Grades: PK–3

Pre-Reading Activity

Explain to your students that they will be listening to a book about a young boy named Milo and his trip on the subway. Have your students think-pair-share about how they get to school each day. Do they drive to school? Do they ride the bus? Do they walk? What do they see on their journey to school? Say, “In this story, Milo interacts with many different people, and in doing so, his imagination goes wild. Let’s think about all the things that Milo imagines on his journey.”

Post-Reading Activity

Throughout the book, Milo rides the subway with his sister to visit his mom. He imagines what the people around him will do after they get off the subway and creates a story through drawings in his journal. Have your students think back to their discussion on how they get to school each day. Then have them draw or write about their own journey and have them add some of their own imagination to it! After creating their imaginative journeys, give students the opportunity to share with the class.
