The Day the Crayons Made Friends

Grades: PK-2

Pre-Reading Activity

Tell students that they are going to listen to a story about crayons who are trying to make new friends. Show the book cover and read the title aloud. Ask students:

- What do you think this story will be about?
- How do you think the crayons might become friends?

Have a class discussion:

- · How do you make new friends?
- What are some ways we can help others feel included and welcome?

Post-Reading Activity

In this story, each crayon finds a way to connect with another crayon and make a new friend. Talk as a class about the different ways the crayons helped one another and how their friendships formed.

Discuss these questions:

- How did each crayon make friends and help someone else?
- Where were all of the crayons before they came back together?
- · How do you think the crayons ended up in different places?
- What happened to the blue crayon?
- How did Duncan get all of his crayons back together?

Share with the class: The crayons made new friends and helped each other out! If you were one of the crayons, how would you help someone feel included? Write a letter to your favorite crayon to tell them how you would be a good friend. You can share what you've been up to and how you'd help make sure everyone feels welcome—just like they did in the story!
