

- **6.** A wild mammal that has a pointed nose, pointed ears, and a bushy tail and is closely related to coyotes and dogs



- 1. A rodent that lives in burrows and come out at night to find food, often kept as a pet.
- **4.** A wild mammal that has a pointed nose, pointed ears, and a bushy tail. They are closely related to coyotes, dogs, and foxes.
- 5. A small mammal that flies, having a small body and large wings covered with skin. They use sound to find and catch flying insects.
- 7. A very small animal with a pointed nose and a very short tail. They are brown and yellow fur with spines that stick out and protect them when they roll into a ball. They make tunnels in rows of bushes called hedges.
- 9. A mammal with very long front legs and shorter back legs. They look something like dogs, but are more closely related to cats, and have a cry that sounds like strange human laughter.

- 2. A large mammal with short yellow or gray fur and black spots. Those with very dark fur are called panthers.
- 3. A small mammal with gray fur, a pointed nose, and a long tail, which it uses to hang from tree branches. This animal is the only marsupial that lives in North America.
- **6.** A bird with large eyes set in front of a large head with sharp claws. They are most active at night and hunt other animals for food.
- 8. A small, jumping animal with smooth, moist skin, long back legs, webbed feet, and no tail.
- **10.** A very small mammal with gray or brown fur. They have pointed faces, round ears, and long tails with no fur.













